An "A" project will meet all deadlines and satisfy the following guidelines.	
Where Historians Disagree [Nov. 17 ]	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• copy and hand in at least two examples of historians' contrasting opinions</li><li>• both from published books</li><li>• both sources are correctly cited</li><li>• annotations explain the relevance of each source to RQ</li></ul>
Where Documents Disagree [Dec. 1 ]	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Research Question is appropriate</li><li>• copy and hand in at least 4 edited primary documents</li><li>• all documents are correctly cited</li><li>• annotations explain the relevance of all documents to the RQ</li></ul>
Prompt [Jan. 8th]	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• prompt raises an issue to which there are (at least) two sides to argue</li></ul>
DBQ [Jan. 10th]	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• between 6-8 documents</li><li>• 1-2 documents are non-narrative</li><li>• 1-2 documents are secondary (historians' opinions)</li><li>• all documents contain information relevant to prompt</li><li>• all documents are preceded by a brief introduction</li></ul>
Final bibliography [Jan. 11 <sup>th</sup> ]	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• all documents are correctly cited</li><li>• annotations explain the relevance of all documents to the prompt</li></ul>
